
Goals of this poster

Origination of the idea

What do you need to do for this assignment?

- 1. You can make your poster in PowerPoint or Canva (email me if you want access). The display case we will have for these posters will be 24 x 36. Resumes posters will be oriented vertically.
- 2. Include the following components
 - a. Header section
 - i. Name
 - ii. Class
 - iii. Accomplishments you are most proud of
 - b. Information on projects
 - i. Should include title and information on the project (ex. could include pictures, abstract, awards)
 - ii. Projects (as an example)
 - 1. STEM I overview
 - 2. STEM II
 - 3. Apps for Good
 - c. Other/optional
 - Could include the Lang film, special CS projects, major physics labs, major math projects, cool Hum work, STEM work outside of school, publications, or other projects outside of school including athletic/scouting/club accomplishments
 - ii. Could list other accomplishments along the bottom of the poster
 - d. Senior Advisors will review resume posters during the first week of October. Posters will be printed out and displayed in MAMS.
